Description: Pick your Partner. Saturday is modified better ball – both balls count on holes 3,11,and 13. Sunday both balls count on holes 6,10,and 12. Teams are flighted by the team handicaps. Handicaps are 90% of course handicap.

Schedule:

Players in Flight 4 will all play from the WHITE tees. Players in Flight 3 will all play from the ORANGE tees. Players in Flights 1-2 will all play from the BLUE tees.

Friday 6:00 PM – Player Evaluation – BRING CASH!

Rules this year. Please read. Pot split is 4 places. Team owner gets (40/30/20/10) percent of flight pot. Minimum team purchase price is \$250. Bid increments are \$50. Teams that are not purchased will go into a flight FIELD Pool which will be purchased as a lot by the highest bidder. A FIELD Pool team <u>does not</u> have the option to buy half.

Day money will not be included in the Calcutta. Individual teams may participate in the day money pool (see below). Calcutta owners will not share in the day money.

Saturday 6:30 AM – Tee time start

Saturday 5:30 PM (approx.) – Horse Race for those that qualify and have declared that they want to play. Top 2 teams net in each flight – if a team does not want to play then the next team will be asked. It is up to each team who says at sign in that they will play to check with the PRO shop if they leave before the horse race participants are determined to see if they are in. Failure to appear costs that team the \$50 entrance fee. If you say maybe, your response is no. Play will start on hole #1.

Sunday 8:00 AM - Shotgun start. We will play 6-somes.

IMPORTANT:

- ALL HOLES SHOULD HAVE BOTH A GROSS AND NET SCORE FOR THE TEAM

- PICK UP YOUR BALL WHEN YOU ARE OUT OF THE HOLE TO SPEED PLAY

Additional Rules

1. All USGA and Local Rules apply. Questions as to the rules of golf shall be referred to the Rules Committee. Do not use the drop area on any holes (specifically #6 and #12).

2. When the player's ball is on the putting green, the player, his partner or either of their caddies may, before but not during the stroke, point out a line for putting, but in so doing the putting green must not be touched. A mark must not be placed anywhere to indicate a line for putting. You may not stand behind your partner as he strokes the putt.

3. Scorecards must be completed correctly. A signed, accurate, fully completed scorecard must be turned in to the tournament table after the completion of play. This scorecard must include a legible hole-by-hole score, gross and net scores where applicable, any other line which pertains to the tournament format completed.

OPTIONAL \$40 per team skins pool will be collected at sign up on Sat.

OPTIONAL \$40 per team Day Money pool will be collected at sign up on Sat. Day money pays 4

places split (40/30/20/10). Half paid out each day

CTP will be individual for both Saturday and Sunday.
