Rules:

- 1. No Consolation Bracket, single elimination tournament. There will be a consolation match for the final four.
- 2. Match results will be posted on the LTMGC bulletin board. Please work with your next round opponents to schedule matches as soon as the information is available to you.
- 3. Turn all completed and signed Match Play scorecards in to the Pro Shop. Record match outcome on the Match Play bulletin board in the locker room and check any announcements.

- 4. TEAM MATCH PLAY ONLY: Instead of resolving un-played matches via the proverbial coin flips, we encourage the use of SUBSTITUTES (someone not playing as an Individual or Team Member) from our LTMGC Membership with valid handicaps and/or any of the following provisions that apply:
 - a. Your substitute must be cleared by the Match Play Chairman.
 - b. Have a LTMGC Tournament Handicap within 6 strokes of the player being substituted.
 - c. The substitute will incur a TWO (2) STROKE PENALTY/DEDUCTION from his current Tournament Handicap for the match.
 - d. It is always an option for a player to compete alone versus the opposing team.
 - e. You can ONLY substitute one match up to the quarter finals. No substitutions for quarterfinals or beyond.
- 5. The desire is to have all matches played within the designated 3 week time frame. If this does not happen, even with the availability of substitutes, the Match Play Chairman will resort to a coin toss on Sunday night. NO EXTENSIONS!
- 6. Match Play is open to Tournament members with an established LTMGC Tournament Handicap.
 - **Note to 2015 New Members** Matches will played using your LHI (Lowest Handicap Index), until you have an established LTMGC Tournament Handicap. If you do not have an established LHI within the USGA GHIN system, you will NOT qualify for Match Play.
- 7. All matches will be played at Lone Tree Golf Course. Matches having only players below a tournament index of 16.1 will be played from the blue tees. Matches having one or more players with a tournament index of 16.1 or greater will have options for play from white tees or blue tees (Please see individual and team rules addendums on the LTMGC website for optional white tee play).

Important Notes

- Four brackets will be established according to handicap.
- The most current LTMGC Tournament Handicaps (or LHI for New Members) will apply to all participants and
 players will wheel off the lower / lowest handicap player in the match. Check the bulletin board, determine tee
 box, appropriate strokes and adjust the card before teeing off.
- Individual matches will be played at 100% of course handicap throughout the entire competition.
- Team matches are to be played at 90% of course handicap throughout the entire competition.
- New for 2015, players will NOT post their scores into GHIN as tournament rounds. These matches will be considered a "Home" score when posting.
- Remember, once the match has been decided, no more than net par will be recorded for the remaining holes.
