## 2017 Pro's Challenge Tournament

The Pro's Challenge is a Net Best Ball event using a Modified Stableford Scoring System between a team of 2 LTMGC Members against a Team of 2 Lone Tree Professionals. There will be a total of 20 matches throughout the season scheduled for Tuesday mornings. Members are limited to signing up for only one match. Signup will begin at the New Member Orientation meeting scheduled for Friday March 17, 2017.

**The Scoring System for the 2017 Tournament is as follows: Each Team will combine the Total Score accumulated by the LTMGC Team in conjunction with the Points +/- Difference to determine the Winning Places. Below is an example of 20 teams utilizing this Scoring System:**

### RULES:

There are just a few rules that apply to this tournament.

1. You are required to play on your scheduled Match date. If a conflict arises, you must contact John Younce (john.younce@lmgc.com) to advise of the conflict and you are then responsible for rescheduling your Match with the applicable Pro's. Try to reschedule within 3 weeks of your original date.
2. If you need to replace your partner due to injury or other circumstances, this must be approved by John Younce prior to your match.
3. All USGA and Local Rules are in effect.
4. After your round, **YOU MUST SIGN and leave your scorecard in the Pro Shop and post your score to GHIN as a Tournament.**

### FORMAT:

Net Best Ball of teams using a Modified Stableford Scoring System. Record your individual gross score and then record the Best Ball for the team and that is your Stableford score for that hole. Then at the end of the Match, you calculate the difference between your team Stableford score and the Pros Stableford team score, that is your plus or minus points for the tournament. Then you ADD these Points to the LTMGC Team Score to determine the Teams TOTAL Points/Score.

-1 Points for a Double Bogey or worse (2 or more Strokes Over)

0 Points for a Bogey (1 Stroke Over)

1 Point for a Par

2 Points for a Birdie (1 Stroke Under)

5 Points for an Eagle (2 Strokes Under)

8 Points for an Albatross (3 Strokes Under)



**TEES:** As with last year, instead of everyone playing from the Blue Tees, you may play from the tee based on your current 100% CRS HCP, not the 90% adjustment. It is your choice what tee you want to play from based on your CRS HCP.

- BLUE Tees ---0 to 14 CRS HCP – Slope 129, Rating 70.6 – No adjustment
- ORANGE Tees --- 15 to 20 CRS HCP – Slope 127, Rating 69.4 – **Subtract 1 stroke**
- WHITE Tees --- 21 and higher CRS HCP – Slope 129, Rating 68.4 – **Subtract 2 strokes**

**HANDICAPS:** Because of the Mixed Tee Event, make 3 adjustments to your Course Handicap

1. On your play date, please reference the LT Tournament HCP worksheet for your current LT Tournament HCP and cross reference that CRS HCP to the tees you will be playing for the event.
2. If playing from an Orange or White Tee, subtract the additional stroke(s). Maximum of 36 strokes are allowed!
3. Then take that revised CRS HCP and adjust to 90% because of the team event and round up or down. (.0 to .4 Round down and .5 to .9 round up) *Example: Orange tee CRS HCP 19, adjust to 18 CRS HCP, 90% of 18 is 16.3, New CRS HCP 16.*
4. After your round, **post your own score to GHIN as a tournament round**

The Pros HCP's are fixed for the entire year. Sometimes the pros schedule may change throughout the year so please use the following Course HCP's for the pros. These HCP's are listed at 90% so no further adjustment is required.
