LTMGC also competes in the season long Colorado Golf Association Team Interclub. The CGA Team Interclub is a very exciting competition between the various Colorado Golf Clubs. We are very proud of the fact that we won this state championship two years running, 2011 and 2012 (it seems so long ago). 2023 would be a great year to bring the championship back to Lone Tree.

We also participate in the District Cup. This is a competition with South Suburban Golf Course and Littleton Golf Course for bragging rights in the South Suburban Recreation District. We prevailed in 2022 playing the competition at our home course, the 2023 addition of this competition will be played at South Suburban Golf Course in August.

We run all our tournaments through the Golf Genius program and scoring through the Golf Genius app. This program allowed us to conduct tournaments and scoring during the pandemic and has proven to be invaluable to us as a club. Upcoming tournament communications and sign ups also go through the Golf Genius program.
