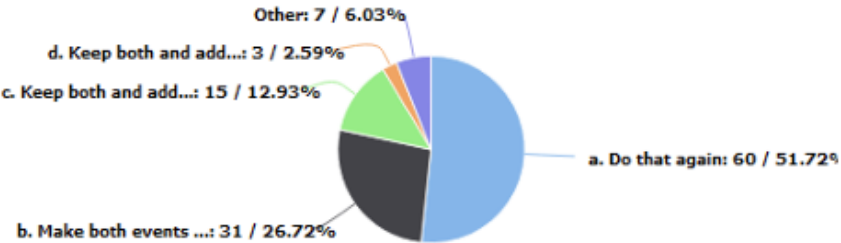




Lone Tree Men's Club 2025 Survey Results

Last year we offered one two-man event where you picked your partner and one where we assigned you a partner. How do you feel about that?

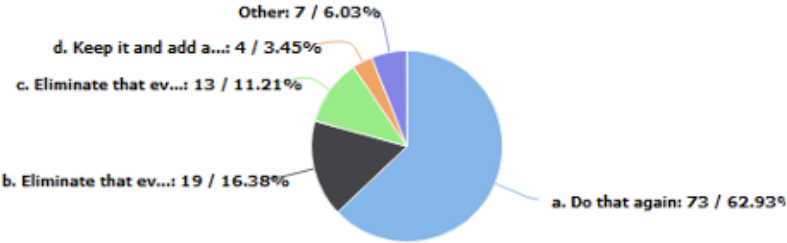


Given this response level we will most like keep offering the two types of partner events for the single day tournaments.

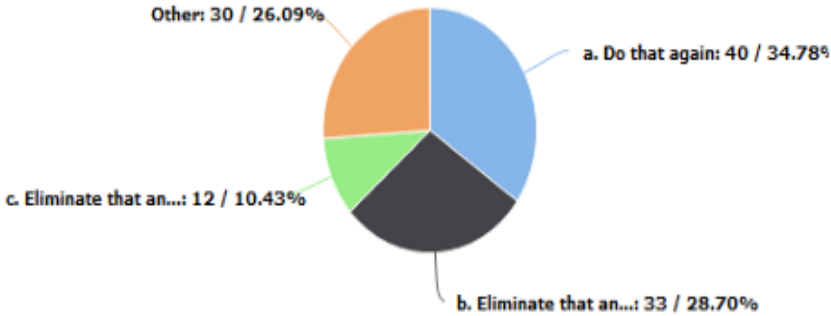

We will re-evaluate the Friday night event and most likely do something different around the Member/Member tournament.

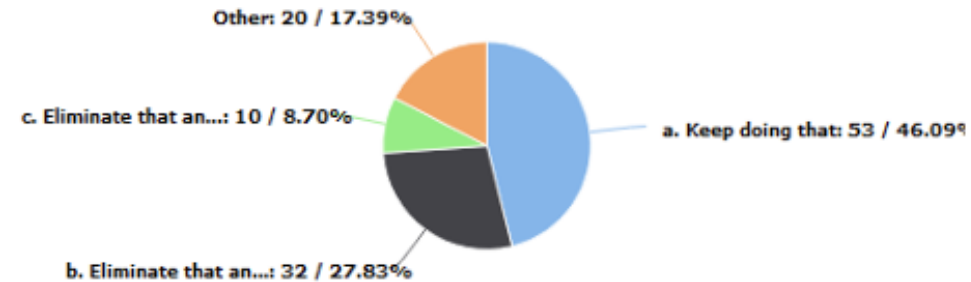
Many of the “other” responses were a desire for a Calcutta or non-committal about what to do.

Last year, we offered trophies to the flight winners in the Member-Member. How did you feel about that?



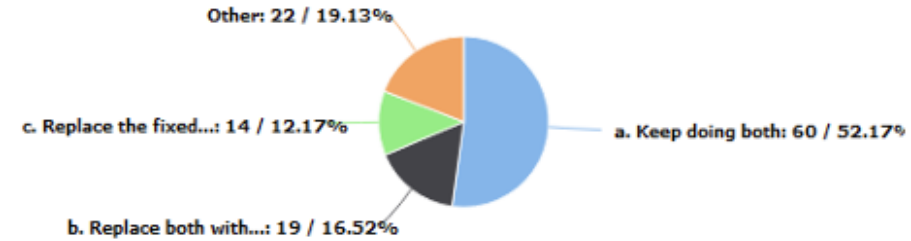

For the last few years, we have offered a fixed price team buy in and day money for the Member-Member. How do you feel about that?



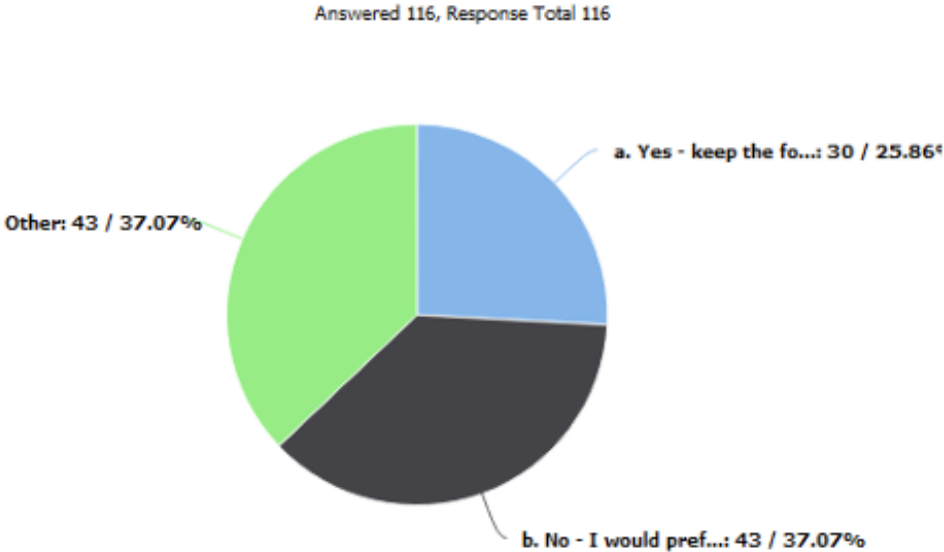

The board will evaluate. “Other” did not have any trends in the answers to influence the other answer percentages

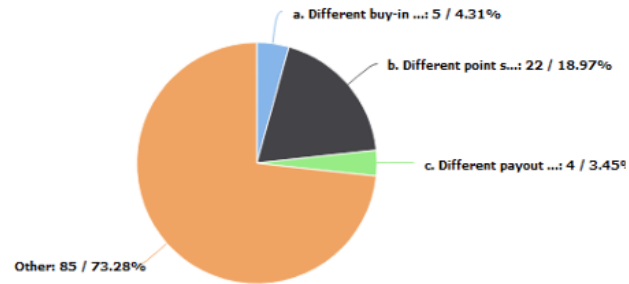

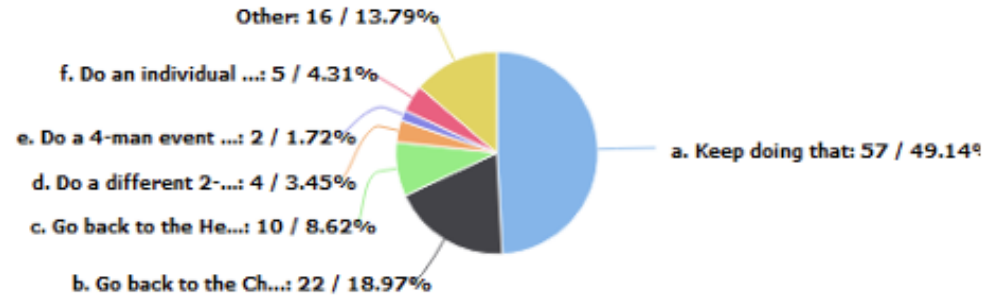

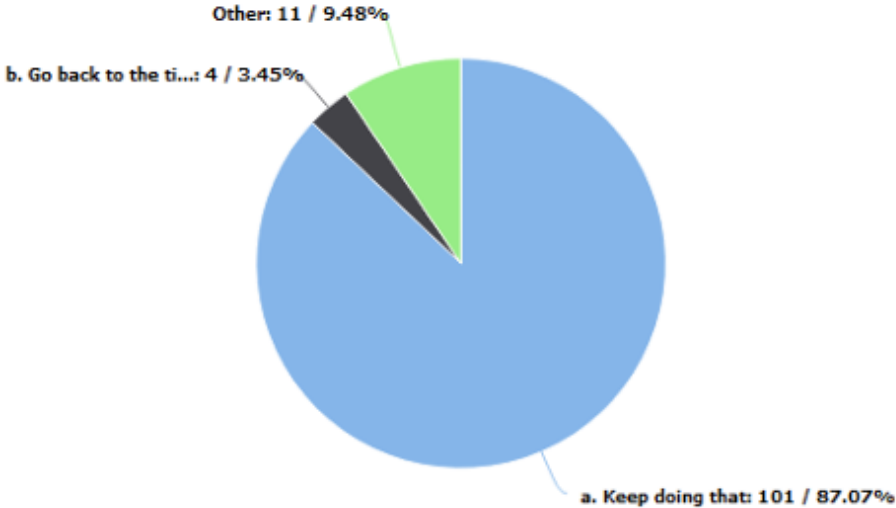

It's rare to get near consensus on much, but it seems we have it here. The timeclock will be gone!

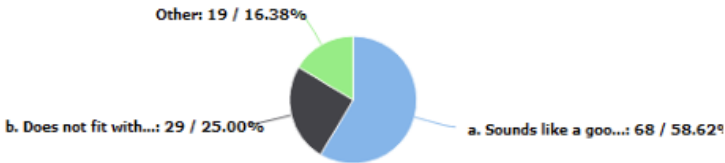

Some members have suggested publishing pace of play data as a way of applying pressure to repeat offenders to improve their pace of play. How do you feel about that?

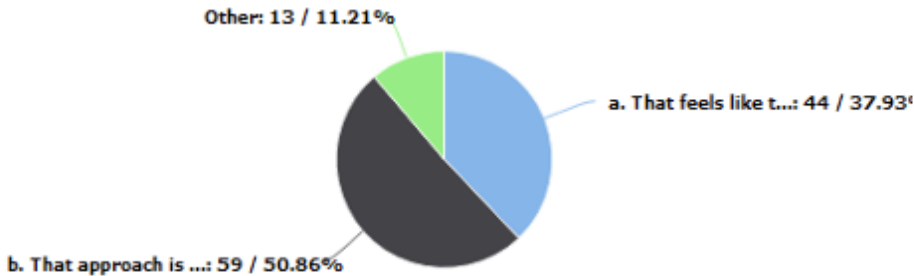
The board will review options for 2026 that will get the message out without unduly burdening finalization of tournaments in a timely fashion.
